1. Call to Order and Consideration of Agenda-Todd Palmer

Chair Todd Palmer called the meeting to order at 2:05pm and distributed the agenda.

2. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes -Hatice Akkurt

The minutes of the June 14, 2009 meeting held at Hyatt Regency Hotel, Atlanta, GA, were distributed. The meeting minutes from June meeting were tabled to add the sections on Best paper Award and to modify the section on by laws. The revised minutes will be distributed to the board members via email by the chair for approval.

3. *Chairs Report* – Todd Palmer

• **Professional Divisions Committee Meeting:** Chair, Todd Palmer, could not attend the divisions chair meeting. However, two of the MCD officers were able to attend the meeting. It has been reported that one of the discussion items was the involvement and interactions with the student divisions. The other discussion item was about a proposal to abolish the consideration of travel distance for student travel support. The proposal recommends a flat rate for non-local students and 25% of the non-local rate for local students.

Ray Gamino motioned to approve the proposal, Tom Evans seconded the motion. The motion approved unanimously.

- **Student Conference:** Several students from the University of Michigan visited the Committee to update the committee about the upcoming student conference, which will be held at the University of Michigan from April 8 to 11, 2010. They mentioned that the website for the conference is up and running. The call for papers is out. They also mentioned that there would be MCD tracks. The students thanked MCD for financially supporting the student conference. At the last meeting MCD decided to support the student conference and the amount was unanimously accepted as \$2500. Students also asked for volunteers from MCD to serve as judge for the presentations, session chairs, and mentors.
- Web Design: ANS is considering a template for all professional divisions, hosted by ANS. If they so choose, divisions can adopt the template. Currently, Oregon State University hosts the MCD website and it is up to date.
- **Training Sessions for Reviewers:** Tom Sutton mentioned that ANS is holding several training sessions for program committee and reviewers for the new web-based review program.
